Performance Notes

This exciting arrangement begins with a fanfare, then makes its way through two other styles before returning to a fanfare ending. It also includes that rarest of all rarities: a xylophone solo (not to mention a clarinet solo).

From the composer:

I knew for the King of Games' area that I wanted to do something very different sounding from the rest of soundtrack, and I took inspiration from the musical approach used in many early cartoons, such as the Disney Silly Symphony, Old King Cole, featuring music by Frank Churchill and Bert Lewis. For the original Bourree on the Board, I wanted to combine a more Baroque/Rococo instrumentation, with a more modern approach to improvisation, but still in an older style. Thanks to Jamie Hopkings for creating written out solos for this arrangement.

Kristofer Maddigan is a percussionist, drummer and composer based in Toronto, Canada. As a performer, he has appeared across Canada and abroad. Principal Percussionist of the National Ballet of Canada Orchestra, Kris also works regularly with a wide range of symphonic, jazz, theatre and new music groups around Ontario, Canada, including the Toronto Symphony Orchestra, the National Arts Centre Orchestra and the Esprit Orchestra. His score for the acclaimed 2017 video game CUPHEAD reached #3 on the Billboard Jazz Chart, and was recognized with a BAFTA award for 'Best Music' and a JUNO nomination for 'Best Instrumental Album.'
