From the composer:

One of my favourite tracks from the Delicious Last Course, this is kind of a companion piece to Shootin' and Lootin' from the original game. The original recording features a very unique instrument, the C Melody saxophone, but as this is usually difficult to obtain we have transposed the part onto tenor sax. Thanks to Jamie Hopkings for creating written out solos for this arrangement.

Kristofer Maddigan is a percussionist, drummer and composer based in Toronto, Canada. As a performer, he has appeared across Canada and abroad. Principal Percussionist of the National Ballet of Canada Orchestra, Kris also works regularly with a wide range of symphonic, jazz, theatre and new music groups around Ontario, Canada, including the Toronto Symphony Orchestra, the National Arts Centre Orchestra and the Esprit Orchestra.
